EMS WAREHOUSE ASPHALT SURFACING

Bids are invited for all materials, labor, tools, and services necessary to pave and mark the EMS Warehouse parking lot per the layout and typical section shown on the Overall Site Plan and as described in the Contract Specifications. The project generally consists of the installation upper binder layer and wearing surface asphalt layers, signage, striping and markings as shown on the plans provided.

The entire project shall be completed in **THIRTY (30) calendar days**.
