



Notice to Contractors

Full Depth Reclamation & Resurfacing – Station Drive

Sealed bids will be received by The City of Smiths Station at 2336 Panther Parkway, Smiths Station, AL 36877 or mailed to P.O. Box 250, Smiths Station, AL 36877 until **10:00 AM EST on August 31, 2026** and at that time publicly opened at Smiths Station City Hall, 2336 Panther Parkway, Smiths Station, AL 36877, for constructing the Full Depth Reclamation and Resurfacing of Station Drive in Smiths Station, AL. Length – 0.78 miles

The Entire Project Shall Be Completed in Thirty (30) Working Days.

Plans and Proposals are available online at <https://www.smithsstational.gov/> , or at Smiths Station City Hall, 2336 Panther Parkway, Smiths Station, AL 36877 (ph. 334-297-8771). A Bidding Proposal may be purchased for \$5.00. Plans may be purchased for \$2.00 per set. Checks should be made payable to The City of Smiths Station. Plans and Proposals will be mailed only upon receipt of remittance.

Cashier's check or bid bond for 5% of bid (maximum - \$10,000.00) made payable to The City of Smiths Station must accompany each bid as evidence of good faith. Bids will not be considered unless the bid bond form provided in the proposal is used.

The bracket range is shown only to provide general financial information to contractors and bonding companies concerning the project's complexity and size. This Bracket should not be used in preparing a bid.

The bracket estimate on this project is from \$313,820 to \$366,123.

The bidder's proposal must be submitted on the complete original proposal furnished to him or her by The City of Smiths Station. Bidders and material suppliers must be on the Alabama Department of Transportation's list of approved contractors and suppliers.

The right to reject any or all bids is reserved by The City of Smiths Station, AL.

Ala. Code § 39-3-5 applies to this project. In accordance with *Ala. Code § 39-3-5(a)*, ".... preference shall be given to resident contractors, and a nonresident bidder domiciled in a state having laws granting preference to local contractors shall be awarded Alabama public contracts only on the same basis as the nonresident bidder's state awards contracts to Alabama contractors bidding under similar circumstances; and resident contractors in Alabama, as defined in Section 392-12, be they corporate, individuals, or partnerships, are to be granted preference over nonresidents in awarding of contracts in the same manner and to the same extent as provided by the laws of the state of domicile of the nonresident."

As a condition for award, the business entity and its subcontractors shall not knowingly employ or hire an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. The awarded business entity must provide documentation of enrollment in the E-Verify program. The business must participate in the E-Verify program for the length of the contract.
