

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received by The Water Works Board of the City of Opelika until 2:00 PM local time on Tuesday, December 16, 2025, for the construction of

### South 7<sup>th</sup> Street Water Main Replacement, Krebs Project 25019

at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

A summary of the work items is included below:

- Approximately 2,400 LF of 12-inch diameter D.I. water main
- Approximately 810 LF of 8-inch, 6-inch and 4-inch diameter D.I. water main
- Associated water service installations and transfers
- Associated water main appurtenances and fittings
- Associated Asphalt Paving Replacement

The work of constructing the project will be let under one Contract if an award should be made; and the Owner reserves the right to select the Bid considered by the Owner to be in the best interest of the Owner.

A cashier's check or bid bond payable to The Water Works Board of the City of Opelika in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, but in no event more than \$10,000, must accompany the bidder's proposal. Performance and Payment Bonds and evidence of insurance required in the bid documents will be required at the signing of the Contract.
